Genesis 17:1 (to Abraham) I am God Almighty...

Almighty = having infinite power (used only of God)

Matthew 19:26 with God all things are possible.

Possible = (this word is related to the word for power); ability to alter or control circumstances

Luke 1:37 nothing is impossible with God. (nothing)

Greek – double emphasis on "nothing" ... The old song: Nothing, nothing, absolutely nothing; nothing is too difficult for Thee.

In Revelation 19:6 God is called omnipotent which means all powerful; unlimited power

Job 12:13

To God belong wisdom and power...



To God belong = "God is equated with power"

The Old Testament is filled with stories of his great power:

He brought plagues upon Egypt so that Israel would be freed.

He parted the Red Sea so that Israel could cross over on dry ground.

He fed millions of Israelis in the desert with manna and quail.

He gave Gideon victory with only 300 men against more than 120,000.

By God's power, Samson killed a lion with his bare hands, and defeated 1,000 soldiers singlehandedly.

Elijah outran a chariot in a 14-mile sprint.

Then, there's all the miracles that Jesus performed. He healed the crippled, made the deaf to hear, gave sight to the blind. And by God's power he rose from the dead and lives forevermore. He has infinite, unlimited power.

Romans 1:20 talks about God's eternal power

His power never runs out. Our minds can't really comprehend unlimited, unending power. In my twenties, I did quite a lot of weight training. I went to the gym everyday doing bench presses; flies; squats; curls; etc. I know others that did far more than I ever did. But over the years, we have all faded. The strength is not what it once was. But God's power is eternal – it never fades.

--A.W. Tozer... The great God Almighty... has now the same amount of power that he had when he made the heaven and the earth and called the stars into being. He will never have any less power than he has now, nor will he ever have any more since he has all the power there is. His is an effortless power, because effort means I'm expending energy, but when God works, he doesn't expend energy. He is energy! With effortless power, God did and is doing his redeeming work.

Since God has the ability always to do anything he wills to do, then nothing is harder or easier with God. He can make a sun and a star and a galaxy just as easily as he can lift a robin off a nest. Nothing is too hard for God – nothing whatsoever. Nothing! In all God's wisdom and power, he is able to do anything as easily as he is able to do anything else.

The story is told of a certain bunch of scientists who came to God one day. They said, "Well, God, we've finally done it. We truly have no use for you anymore. We have figured out how to make man out of the dirt, just like you did." God said, "Really? What do you say we have a man-making contest, okay?" And the scientists said, "You're on."
