Synopsis

The cross paid for sin... the resurrection proved it was enough.

Highlights



BIG IDEA — The cross paid for sin, and the resurrection proved it was enough.

THE PROBLEM — Sin creates separation—and requires justice.

“Christ died for our sins...” (1 Corinthians 15:3)

Notes:

THE PLAN — The cross was not an accident. It was always the plan of God.

“He was pierced for our transgressions...” (Isaiah 53:5)

Notes:

THE COST — The cross reveals the cost of sin and the depth of substitution.

“God made him who had no sin to be sin for us...” (2 Corinthians 5:21)

Notes:

THE QUESTION — Did the cross actually accomplish what it came to do?

“If Christ has not been raised... you are still in your sins.” (1 Corinthians 15:17)

Notes:

READ THE FULL STORY

Matthew 27–28

Mark 15–16

Luke 23–24

John 19–20



FRIDAY — Friday was the payment. Sin was judged, and justice was satisfied.

“Christ died for our sins...” (1 Corinthians 15:3)

Notes:

SUNDAY — Sunday was the proof. The resurrection declares the payment was accepted.

“Christ has indeed been raised...” (1 Corinthians 15:20)

Notes:

WHAT THIS MEANS — Because of the cross, sin is dealt with. Because of the resurrection, death is defeated.

“In Christ all will be made alive.” (1 Corinthians 15:22)

Notes:

REFLECTION — What does it mean that the cross was enough and the resurrection proves it?

Notes:

TAKE THIS WITH YOU - The cross was always the **plan**. The resurrection was never in doubt. Friday was the **payment**. Sunday was the **proof**. And eternity is the **promise** for everyone who believes.

He is risen; He is risen indeed!
